#### Mark 2:22 (NKJV)

And no one puts new wine into old wineskins; or else the new wine bursts the wineskins, the wine is spilled, and the wineskins are ruined. But new wine must be put into new wineskins."

#### Job 32:19 (NKJV)

<sup>19</sup> Indeed my belly *is* like wine *that* has no vent; It is ready to burst like new wineskins.

#### Romans 8:29 (NKJV)

<sup>29</sup> For whom He foreknew, He also predestined *to be* conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.

### Romans 12:1-2 (NKJV)

- <sup>1</sup> I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, *which is* your reasonable service.
- <sup>2</sup> And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

### 2 Corinthians 3:18 (NKJV)

<sup>18</sup> But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.

### Ephesians 5:18 (NKJV)

<sup>18</sup> And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit,

### The Vineyard

#### John 15:5, 4, 8 (NKJV)

- <sup>5</sup> I am the vine, you *are* the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.
- <sup>4</sup> Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me.
- <sup>8</sup> By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.

### The Wine

#### Isaiah 5:1-7 (NKJV)

- <sup>1</sup> Now let me sing to my Well-beloved A song of my Beloved regarding His vineyard: My Well-beloved has a vineyard On a very fruitful hill.
- <sup>2</sup> He dug it up and cleared out its stones, And planted it with the choicest vine. He built a tower in its midst, And also made a winepress in it; So He expected *it* to bring forth *good* grapes, But it brought forth wild grapes.
- <sup>3</sup> "And now, O inhabitants of Jerusalem and men of Judah, Judge, please, between Me and My vineyard.
- <sup>4</sup> What more could have been done to My vineyard That I have not done in it? Why then, when I expected *it* to bring forth *good* grapes, Did it bring forth wild grapes?
- <sup>5</sup> And now, please let Me tell you what I will do to My vineyard: I will take away its hedge, and it shall be burned; *And* break down its wall, and it shall be trampled down.
- <sup>6</sup> I will lay it waste; It shall not be pruned or dug, But there shall come up briers and thorns. I will also command the clouds That they rain no rain on it."
- <sup>7</sup> For the vineyard of the LORD of hosts *is* the house of Israel, And the men of Judah are His pleasant plant. He looked for justice, but behold, oppression; For righteousness, but behold, a cry *for help*.

#### Isaiah 27:2-6 (NKJV)

- <sup>2</sup> In that day sing to her, "A vineyard of red wine!
- <sup>3</sup> I, the LORD, keep it, I water it every moment; Lest any hurt it, I keep it night and day.
- <sup>4</sup> Fury *is* not in Me. Who would set briers *and* thorns Against Me in battle? I would go through them, I would burn them together.
- <sup>5</sup> Or let him take hold of My strength, *That* he may make peace with Me; *And* he shall make peace with Me."
- <sup>6</sup> Those who come He shall cause to take root in Jacob; Israel shall blossom and bud, And fill the face of the world with fruit.

### Luke 20:9-16, 19 (NKJV)

- <sup>9</sup> Then He began to tell the people this parable: "A certain man planted a vineyard, leased it to vinedressers, and went into a far country for a long time.
- <sup>10</sup> Now at vintage-time he sent a servant to the vinedressers, that they might give him some of the fruit of the vineyard. But the vinedressers beat him and sent *him* away empty-handed.
- <sup>11</sup> Again he sent another servant; and they beat him also, treated *him* shamefully, and sent *him* away empty-handed.
- <sup>12</sup> And again he sent a third; and they wounded him also and cast *him* out.
- <sup>13</sup> Then the owner of the vineyard said, 'What shall I do? I will send my beloved son. Probably they will respect *him* when they see him.'
- <sup>14</sup> But when the vinedressers saw him, they reasoned among themselves, saying, 'This is the heir. Come, let us kill him, that the inheritance may be ours.'
- <sup>15</sup> So they cast him out of the vineyard and killed *him*. Therefore what will the owner of the vineyard do to them?
- <sup>16</sup> He will come and destroy those vinedressers and give the vineyard to others." And when they heard *it* they said, "Certainly not!"
- <sup>19</sup> And the chief priests and the scribes that very hour sought to lay hands on Him, but they feared the people--for they knew He had spoken this parable against them.

#### Luke 6:43-44 (NKJV)

- <sup>43</sup> "For a good tree does not bear bad fruit, nor does a bad tree bear good fruit.
- <sup>44</sup> For every tree is known by its own fruit. For *men* do not gather figs from thorns, nor do they gather grapes from a bramble bush.

#### Matthew 12:33 (NKJV)

<sup>33</sup> "Either make the tree good and its fruit good, or else make the tree bad and its fruit bad; for a tree is known by *its* fruit.

#### Amos 9:13 (NKJV)

<sup>13</sup> "Behold, the days are coming," says the LORD, "When the plowman shall overtake the reaper, And the treader of grapes him who sows seed; The mountains shall drip with sweet wine, And all the hills shall flow with it.

## Joel 3:18 (NKJV)

<sup>18</sup> And it will come to pass in that day *That* the mountains shall drip with new wine, The hills shall flow with milk, And all the brooks of Judah shall be flooded with water; A fountain shall flow from the house of the LORD And water the Valley of Acacias.

#### Psalm 4:7 (NKJV)

<sup>7</sup> You have put gladness in my heart, More than in the season that their grain and wine increased.

#### Psalm 104:15 (NKJV)

<sup>15</sup> And wine *that* makes glad the heart of man, Oil to make *his* face shine, And bread *which* strengthens man's heart.

#### Joel 3:13 (NKJV)

<sup>13</sup> Put in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe. Come, go down; For the winepress is full, The vats overflow-- For their wickedness *is* great."

#### Revelation 14:10, 19 (NKJV)

- <sup>10</sup> he himself shall also drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out full strength into the cup of His indignation. He shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb.
- <sup>19</sup> So the angel thrust his sickle into the earth and gathered the vine of the earth, and threw *it* into the great winepress of the wrath of God.

### Galatians 5:22-24 (NKJV)

- <sup>22</sup> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,
- <sup>23</sup> gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.
- <sup>24</sup> And those *who are* Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

### Ephesians 5:8-10 (NKJV)

- <sup>8</sup> For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light
- <sup>9</sup> (for the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth),
- <sup>10</sup> finding out what is acceptable to the Lord.

### Philippians 1:11 (NKJV)

<sup>11</sup> being filled with the fruits of righteousness which *are* by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

#### Colossians 1:10 (NKJV)

<sup>10</sup> that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing *Him,* being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;

### Luke 5:39 (NKJV)

<sup>39</sup> And no one, having drunk old wine, immediately desires new; for he says, 'The old is better.' "

#### John 2:1-10 (NKJV)

- <sup>1</sup> On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there.
- <sup>2</sup> Now both Jesus and His disciples were invited to the wedding.
- <sup>3</sup> And when they ran out of wine, the mother of Jesus said to Him, "They have no wine."
- <sup>4</sup> Jesus said to her, "Woman, what does your concern have to do with Me? My hour has not yet come."
- <sup>5</sup> His mother said to the servants, "Whatever He says to you, do it."
- <sup>6</sup> Now there were set there six waterpots of stone, according to the manner of purification of the Jews, containing twenty or thirty gallons apiece.
- <sup>7</sup> Jesus said to them, "Fill the waterpots with water." And they filled them up to the brim.
- <sup>8</sup> And He said to them, "Draw *some* out now, and take *it* to the master of the feast." And they took *it*.
- <sup>9</sup> When the master of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and did not know where it came from (but the servants who had drawn the water knew), the master of the feast called the

#### bridegroom.

<sup>10</sup> And he said to him, "Every man at the beginning sets out the good wine, and when the *guests* have well drunk, then the inferior. You have kept the good wine until now!"

#### Isaiah 55:1 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> "Ho! Everyone who thirsts, Come to the waters; And you who have no money, Come, buy and eat. Yes, come, buy wine and milk Without money and without price.

#### The Need for a Wineskin

#### Acts 2:17-18 (NKJV)

- <sup>17</sup> 'And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, That I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your young men shall see visions, Your old men shall dream dreams.
- <sup>18</sup> And on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days; And they shall prophesy.

### The Old Wineskin

#### **Mark 7:9 (NKJV)**

<sup>9</sup> He said to them, "All too well you reject the commandment of God, that you may keep your tradition.

## Galatians 3:1-3 (NKJV)

- <sup>1</sup> O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you that you should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ was clearly portrayed among you as crucified?
- <sup>2</sup> This only I want to learn from you: Did you receive the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?
- <sup>3</sup> Are you so foolish? Having begun in the Spirit, are you now being made perfect by the flesh?

#### Romans 7:6 (NKJV)

<sup>6</sup> But now we have been delivered from the law, having died to what we were held by, so that we should serve in the newness of the Spirit and not *in* the oldness of the letter.

#### The New Wineskin

### 1 Samuel 16:7 (NKJV)

<sup>7</sup> But the LORD said to Samuel, "Do not look at his appearance or at the height of his stature, because I have refused him. For *the Lord does* not *see* as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart."

### Romans 2:27-29 (NKJV)

- <sup>27</sup> And will not the physically uncircumcised, if he fulfills the law, judge you who, *even* with *your* written *code* and circumcision, *are* a transgressor of the law?
- <sup>28</sup> For he is not a Jew who *is one* outwardly, nor *is* circumcision that which *is* outward in the flesh;
- <sup>29</sup> but *he is* a Jew who *is one* inwardly; and circumcision *is that* of the heart, in the Spirit, not in the letter; whose praise *is* not from men but from God.

#### Psalm 51:6 (NKJV)

<sup>6</sup> Behold, You desire truth in the inward parts, And in the hidden *part* You will make me to know wisdom.

# **Containing the Glory**

### 2 Chronicles 2:6 (NKJV)

<sup>6</sup> But who is able to build Him a temple, since heaven and the heaven of heavens cannot contain Him? Who *am* I then, that I should build Him a temple, except to burn sacrifice before Him?

### Acts 7:48-50 (NKJV)

- <sup>48</sup> However, the Most High does not dwell in temples made with hands, as the prophet says:
- <sup>49</sup> 'Heaven is My throne, And earth is My footstool. What house will you build for Me? says the LORD, Or what is the place of My rest?
- 50 Has My hand not made all these things?'

## Ephesians 1:4 (NKJV)

<sup>4</sup> just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love,

### Ephesians 1:22-23 (NKJV)

- <sup>22</sup> And He put all *things* under His feet, and gave Him *to be* head over all *things* to the church,
- <sup>23</sup> which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.

### Habakkuk 2:14 (NKJV)

<sup>14</sup> For the earth will be filled With the knowledge of the glory of the LORD, As the waters cover the sea.
